



We realize our tuition amounts can be a challenge. Our Financial aid program might be able to offer a reduction in our preschool tuition if your family is eligible. We use the process offered by School and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS). SSS processes financial aid data for preschools, elementary schools, secondary schools and colleges all across the nation. Its formulas for calculating financial aid are based on years of data collected from thousands of schools. These formulas are extremely complex and take into account a myriad of factors. We believe this is the most fair way we could find to determine eligibility.

If you are interested in finding out if your family might be eligible, please request a financial aid packet. The required information is submitted directly to SSS who will then send their evaluation of need to us. Based on this calculation of each family's need, many of our families receive partial grants that make our tuition more affordable.

The deadline for submitting the required application and information is **April 30**. If we have available funds in our Financial Aid budget after the first round of awards, we will continue to accept applications after that date but will only be able to grant aid until our Financial Aid budget for the year is exhausted. All information pertaining to a family's financial aid request is kept confidential.

Coastal Community Preschool's Financial Aid Policy: Coastal Community Preschool offers tuition assistance to preschool students whose family financial circumstances qualify them for such assistance, subject to budgetary constraints. In determining eligibility, the Preschool also seeks to equalize disbursement of tuition assistance amongst the age ranges of enrolled students. The assistance offered is a percentage of the actual demonstrated need, with second and subsequent children from the same family typically receiving a higher percentage of need. The actual percentage of need offered each school year will be based on budgetary constraints of the school. Priority for financial aid will be given to families who complete their income and total assets documentation and enroll (or re-enroll) early. The decisions to accept a student for enrollment at Coastal Community Preschool, and to award tuition assistance, are separate.
